On Saturday, March 6, 2021, Dan Paul Terrell, a loving father, leader and friend, passed away at the age of 72.

Dan was born on February 12, 1949, to JoAnn and Paul Terrell in Stillwell, Oklahoma. He was the captain of his Putnum City Highschool football team, a champion wrestler and an incredible baseball player. Dan moved to Santa Fe in 1971, where he built the largest title company, Territorial Abstract and Title Company, in the state and became a successful real estate developer. Dan was preceded in death by his father and mother, Paul and JoAnn Terrell. He is survived by his two daughters, Patricia Ann White and Lara Elise Terrell,

Dan is survived by his three brothers David Edward Terrell, Donald Freeman & his wife Roxanne Terrell, and Richard Ralph Terrell.
