Gloria Mocchiola Capasso 5-12-1925 to 1-30-2016 Gloria Mocchiola Capasso passed away January 30, 2016, at the age of 90. She was preceded in death by her parents, Tony and Lucille Mocchiola, and her beloved brothers, Eugene and Robert. She is survived by her daughter, Mary Beth Fujarski, and son-in-law, Stan Fujarski; granddaughters, Katie Fujarski and Amy Decker (Matt); brother, Carmine Cirillo (Judy), sisters-in-law Virginia Mocchiola and Mimi Mocchiola, many nieces, nephews and cousins. First and foremost in her life were faith and family. Gloria taught Cosmetology at O'Fallon Technical High School in St. Louis for about 16 years, and is remembered fondly by her former students. The Memorial Mass will be held on Saturday, February 13, at St. Jude at 12:30. Visitation with the family will be at 12 noon.
