Dr. Jack Ridings Pruet, age 79, passed away at his home in Houston, Texas on Wednesday, March 10, 2021. He was born on October 31, 1941, to Sarah Drucilla Pruet and Jasper Battle Pruet.

Dr. Pruet graduated from The University of Texas medical school in San Antonio, Texas in 1971 and practiced medicine for over 40 years. He had a competitive spirit, especially on the golf course, and was passionate about research and learning new things.
