After her husband's death, Marianne became an assistant to an attorney in Dallas. Marianne was a truly a courageous woman who survived the war and became a friend to everyone she met. She loved the performing arts, especially the opera and the ballet. A graveside burial will take place at the Hillcrest Memorial Cemetery on Northwest Highway at 2:00 p.m. on Monday, January 26.
