Michael " Steve" Orr passed away at Houston Methodist Hospital - Sugar Land on July 4, 2014 at the age of 64 of respiratory failure. Steve really enjoyed his yearly fishing trip to Grand Isle with the Tanner family - his extended family. He also enjoyed the nights he and his friend Don would burn some steaks and go fishing the next morning. One of Steve's favorite hobbies was building custom-made saltwater fishing rods when he had extra time on his hands. He loved animals and in the evening would feed and watch doves and squirrels eat food on his driveway/sidewalk. His Border collie, Cody and rescued dog, Lady, were his constant

companions.
