



## Michael Zelkovich

September 18, 1946 - August 6, 2024

Michael “Mike” Zelkovich, 77, passed away Tuesday, August 6, 2024, in Plano, TX

Mike was born on September 18, 1946, in Frankfurt am Main, Germany to John and Lillian Zelkovich and moved to New York in 1948. He grew up in Washington Heights, NY surrounded by numerous cousins, aunts, and uncles.

He joined the Army shortly after graduating high school. While serving as a signal officer in the US Army, he met his wife, Jean, while stationed in Germany. The two were married on October 7, 1968 in England. In late March 1969, they moved to New York, where they embarked on numerous adventures in the Big Apple. However, their greatest adventure was welcoming their two children: their son, Evan, in 1978, and their daughter, Meagan, two years later in 1980.

In 1985, Mike and Jean moved their young family to Houston, Texas, where Mike worked as a computer programmer for EDS until his retirement. Mike’s passion for travel and adventure provided countless memories, ensuring a well-traveled and fulfilled life. His experiences became cherished stories that he shared with friends and strangers alike, showcasing his charismatic personality and love for life.

Mike was preceded in death by his mother, Lillian, and his father John.

He leaves behind his beloved wife of 55 years, Jean Elizabeth Zelkovich; his son, Evan, and his wife, Jessica, along with their children, Carolyn and Jonathan; and his daughter, Meagan Theilen, and her husband, Tyson, and their four children, Madeline, Beau, Paige, and Parker. Mike's legacy of love, adventure, and cherished memories lives on in the hearts of his family.

A Memorial Service will be held Friday August 16 at 2:15pm at The Legacy at Willowbend in Plano, Texas. Guests are invited to wear a Hawaiian shirt in tribute to Mike's preference for a casual lifestyle and favorite attire.
