Norman Edward Jenne, was born on May 13, 1925 and passed into glory on Sunday, June 19, 2022.

Norman was born in Detroit Michigan and joined the war effort at age 17. He served in World War II and Korea in the Air Force as a Navigator. He graduated from University of Houston in 1950 with a degree in Engineering. Norman went on to have a very successful career in designing and implementing large air conditioning systems in some of the largest skyscrapers in Houston. Norman's wife, Mary was the love of his life and predeceased him in 2015. In the years since then he made many friends with his neighbors and exercise buddies at the YMCA.
