His legacy of love continues through his children: Charles (Angela), Robert (Jennifer), and Stacey (Andrew Hascoe). He was the proud "Pop" to 12

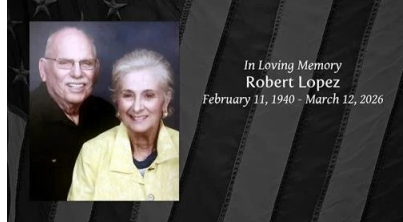
grandchildren and 10 great-grandchildren, with two more expected soon.
