Rosemary Mayorga Parker, 67, of Austin, passed away on Wednesday, April 6, 2016. She was born on July 17, 1948, in Tampico, Mexico, and was part of a very large family, including seven brothers and four sisters. In the 1950s, after the untimely death of her father Salomon Mayorga and at a very young age, she moved to the United States to live with other family.
