Tomas Pedro Gumpel, 78, passed away peacefully on Sunday, July 17, 2022 in Houston. Tomas was born on January 8, 1944 in Buenos Aires, Argentina to the late Joachim Gumpel and Elsbeth Lissner.

Tomas earned a degree in Electronic Engineering in 1970 from the University of Buenos Aires. He moved with his family to Houston in 1983 and became a U.S. citizen in January 1992.

Tomas was a loving partner to his wife, Susana, for 51 years, an amazing father to his sons, and a caring abuelo to his five grandchildren. Tomas shared his lifelong passion for tennis, model trains, and travel with his family. His love for cooking asados brought family and friends together regularly. In addition, Tomas and Susana found great joy in dancing tango and, in later years, volunteering with the Friends of Bellaire Pound to help rescue, care for, and find homes for dogs in need. He believed in kindness and resourcefulness, found humor and joy in daily life, and his grace was apparent to any who knew him.

Tomas is survived by his loving wife, Susana; his sons, Damian and wife Ximena; Elias; Mirko and wife Anna; and his sister Susana Slagt and husband Martin Slagt with their children, Matias and Debbi. He leaves behind 5 beautiful grandchildren, Natalia, Tomas, Emiliana, Matias, and Javier.
