Wilma F Alvey Singleton was born August 29, 1923 in Belton, TX to Frank and Wilta Alvey. She passed away on January 9, 2015 in Plano, TX. She lost her parents at a young age, and was placed at Buckner Baptist Orphan's Home in Dallas, TX at age 6. She graduated salutatorian and received a full college scholarship, but turned it down to stay at Buckner so she could teach and run, as a volunteer, Sunset Home, a school on campus. They taught Sunday School for many years, and were part of the hospitality team. She retired from Texas Instruments in 1987.
